Registration: \$200 by December 1st
\$225 after December 10th

Once submitted, an entry fee will not be returned unless a substitute team is found.

Registration deadline – December 15, 2018 (the league may close registrations early when the allotted number of teams are registered). Do not wait –we have a limit on the number of teams that can enter – maximum 6 teams per division. **We turned away teams last year – register early!**

The tournament will be a pool-play format. Each team is guaranteed three games.

Community Teams only.

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place teams.

Each participant (organization and individual) in this tournament must be covered by their own organization and/or individual insurance.

Admission to the games will be \$3.00 for adults - \$1.00 for seniors and students.

All team members must have matching shirts with clearly visible numbers on the front and/or back of the jersey. No player can play on more than one team in the same division.

All teams will receive a game schedule and gym location on or before December 20th.

2018 Mentor Holiday Basketball Tournament

Game Rules:

Ten Foot Baskets and Youth Basketballs (28.5") will be used for all divisions.

Coaches are asked to report no later than one half hour before game time.

Games will consist of two 18 minute halves. There will be a three minute break for half-time. Overtime periods will be two minutes – the last minute the clock will stop on the whistle.

The clock will run continuously until the last two minutes of the second half.

Teams may play any form of defense – zone, full court press, man to man etc. is permitted the full duration of the game.

When one team is ahead by 15 or more points, the team ahead is not allowed to press in the back court. The clock will also run continuously in the last two minutes of the second half.

Each team will have two timeouts per half. Unused timeouts do not carry over. One additional timeout will be granted for each overtime period.

All referee's decisions are final and not subject to appeal. All decisions from the scorer's table and or by tournament officials are final.

Ejection from the game due to technical fouls or at the referee's discretion will result in said player, coach or spectator being asked to leave the premises. Any player, coach or spectator who is ejected will also be suspended from the next game.

Verbal abuse of the referees from the stands will not be tolerated and will result in automatic removal from the building.

The Tiebreakers for advancement to the semi-finals will be:

1st- Head-to Head 2nd- Point Differential (max 15 points) 3rd-least points allowed
